Club Rules

SKYDIVING:

1. All parachuting at this Centre takes place under the rules laid down by the BPA Operations Manual and The Parachute Centre's Standard Operating Procedures.
2. All visiting jumpers must receive a full DZ brief and have their equipment, documents and BPA membership checked by an Instructor. This will include the procedure for manifesting.
3. All jumpers will receive a "flightline check" by a qualified person in the DZ Control pen. The checker will sign the manifest sheet to acknowledge that the check has been completed.
4. All persons who will be operating the aircraft door must ensure that they are familiar with its operation. If in doubt, ask.
5. All jumpers should ensure that they are qualified and competent to undertake the planned descent and that the people they will be jumping with are qualified and competent.
6. Persons without the CCI's approval will not attempt to land South of the small windsock. No person will land South of the East-West taxiway except in an emergency. This is the "beer line"!
7. Food or drink is not allowed in the Packing Shed.
8. Any questions should be directed to an Instructor or Reception.
9. All discounted deals are non-refundable.

GENERAL:

1. Please park sensibly in the designated area.
2. An airfield is not the place for animals, please leave them at home.
3. Children must be supervised at ALL times. They must not be allowed to sit on the fence or leave the Spectator Area without an adult. Active airfields are dangerous places for the unwary, let's keep it as safe as possible.
4. Please take your rubbish home with you. If you can't take it home, please use the bins provided, it won't clear itself up.
5. Smoking is not allowed anywhere on the airfield except the Spectator Area and NEVER in proximity to parachute equipment.
6. Do not approach the aircraft except under the supervision of a member of staff.
7. Finally, alcohol is not permitted on the airfield until the last aircraft lift of the day has left the ground and no-one will be permitted to jump if they have consumed any alcohol at all that day. Should a member of staff decide that a person is unfit to jump for any reason, they will not be permitted to jump.
